ABSENTEE VOTING: Voting by absent ballot is permitted with respect to the Annual Meeting of the Town of Woodford to be held on Tuesday March 1, 2022. Absentee voting shall be in accordance with the provisions of Chapter51, Title 17 of Vermont Statutes Annotated Section 2531 entitled "Application for Absentee Voter ballot."

Application shall be made to the Clerk of Town of Woodford at the Clerk's regular business office during the Clerk's regular business hours unless otherwise specified by the Clerk.

A voter who expects to be an early or absentee voter, or an authorized person on behalf of such voter, may apply for an early voter absentee ballot until 5:00 P.M. or of the closing of the Town Clerk's office on the day preceding the election.
