WOODFORD, VERMONT. Water's Hill.

This Yard is located on Water's Hill (so called) and is in the woods. It is about 2 miles from the Main Highway - Route 9 - just inside the township of Woodford. The stones are in fine condition and readable. At some time this was a very large yard.
