
The legal voters of the Southwest Vermont Union Elementary School District (the "District"), comprising the voters of the current Bennington School District, Inc., and the current Pownal, Shaftsbury, and Woodford town school districts, are hereby notified and warned to meet on Monday, June 10, 2019 at the SVSU Administrative Offices in Bennington, Vermont at 6:00 PM at which time the Board will hold an informational hearing on the Article to be voted by Australian Ballot on June 11, 2019. Said voters are further notified and warned to meet on Tuesday, June 11, 2019, when the polls will be open to transact the following business by Australian ballot:

Article 1: Shall the voters of the Southwest Vermont Union Elementary School District approve the school board to expend twenty three million, two hundred eleven thousand, eight hundred seventy-five dollars (\$23,211,875), which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$14,935 per equalized pupil. This is the initial year for calculating projected spending per equalized pupil for the Southwest Vermont Union Elementary School District.




