ARTICLE 1

The Mount Anthony Union High School District No.14 Board of School Directors proposes to incur bonded indebtedness to finance construction of certain capital improvements to the Spinelli Complex at Mount Anthony Union High School, including track repairs, installation of an artificial turf system, construction of a multi-use building and site improvements, in an amount not to exceed Three Million Five Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,500,000.00). None (0%) of the project is expected to be eligible for state school construction aid and therefore all (100%) of the costs of the project, \$3,500,000.00, will be the responsibility of the Mount Anthony Union School District. So,

Shall bonds of the Mount Anthony Union High School District No.14 in a principal amount not to exceed Three Million Five Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,500,000.00), subject to reduction by available State or federal funds, if any, be issued to finance construction of capital improvements to the Spinelli Complex (i.e., track repair, artificial turf system, multi-use building, and site upgrades) at Mount Anthony Union High School?

State funds may not be available at the time this project is otherwise eligible to receive State school construction aid. The District is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of State school construction aid.
